

Are you missing important communications from Katy ISD?

The Katy ISD Communications Department exists to support both campuses and administration in an overall effort to connect the District to the community. To help make sure you are tuned in to Katy ISD Communications, we have outlined a number of tools below that we use to communicate with you.

eNews

To receive eNews from a campus or the District, parents need to have a valid email on file with the campus registrar. Community members who wish to receive notifications from a campus or the District can subscribe by visiting the Katy ISD homepage and clicking **SUBSCRIBE** in the box titled "The Katy ISD Update." From there, community members can choose from which campuses they would like to receive messages.

Campus eNews vs. District eNews

Each Katy ISD campus utilizes Blackboard to provide parents with campus updates and notifications.

The District also utilizes Blackboard to send notifications to parents and community members. Emails from the District include Stranger Danger Alerts, Superintendent Messages, and other District-level messages.

The Katy ISD Update

The Katy ISD Update is a District-wide communication tool that sends weekly updates to parents' emails. To subscribe to these emails, click on the Katy ISD Update icon seen above and featured on the District's homepage.

Latest News - RSS Feed

Often referred to as Really Simple Syndication, the RSS Feed allows users to subscribe to a feed and receive notifications when new content is posted. The District's Latest News page has this feature, so parents and community members can have recent news items sent directly to their RSS Feed Reader. Look for the RSS icon located at the top right corner of the Latest News page.
