## NOTES

- The Wolfe Steering Committee and Wolfe Program Design Committee met in a joint meeting to discuss the possibility of reducing the size of the Wolfe IB Program to providing service to 300 students in the PYP and 200 students in the 6-8 MYP.
  
- The committees agreed upon the following:
  - Community needs for a new campus
  - The IB Program should stay at Wolfe
  - A smaller scale IB campus would show a demand faster
  - The community has numerous questions regarding the IB Program
  
- The committees chose not to change the original proposal to the Board of Trustees for the following reasons:
  - A smaller campus would hurt all KISD student sby reducing the IB enrolment and be a disservice to the KISD community
  - Additions would cost more in the future than to build the entire building at current prices
  - Medical facilities being built in the Katy area will impact enrollment because of future jobs/home in the area thus more demand for IB Programs
