### **NOTES**

Discussion was held regarding requirements for enrollment into the Wolfe IB Program. Who would be permitted to attend Wolfe and how the application process would work.

- Wolfe Elementary zoned students would automatically attend the PYP program at the Wolfe location. When reaching sixth grade they would have the option to either attend their zoned campus or to apply for the Wolfe MYP program at the Wolfe campus.
- Orientation for students and parents regarding the advanced academics starting at the end of fifth grade would need to be held so transition to junior high and high school IB programs would be successful.
- One application should be arranged for both a student transfer from the home campus and acceptance into the IB program at Wolfe.
- Acceptance into the Wolfe IB program is to be based on both academic success and behavioral success.
- Each parent and student should be made aware and agree to a more rigorous academic program and know that regular monitoring of student progress will be maintained.
- Applications will be confirmed proportional to the applications received from each campus.
- Diversity is to be promoted through recruiting at all campuses.
- Students with previous IB experience should receive preferred enrollment so that they may complete the Diploma Program.
- Sibling priority should only be given in PYP to younger siblings.
- Students must maintain a "C" average in coursework taken.
- Teacher recommendation is to be included on the application.
- The student is to exhibit potential for meeting the IB profile.
- Architects from PBK attended the meeting to begin the potential facility planning and will return for another meeting in March.
