Senior Parking for 2017-2018

It is almost time to pick your parking spots for next year. You may pick up the new parking packets at lunches on May 10 and 11, or in Room 1628 starting May 10, or online on the CRHS website. Dates for choosing your parking spots are May 16 and 17 after school. Lottery numbers and times will be posted by the library and Room 1628. Please check the posting for the time you are assigned based on your lottery number. You may not come before your time. If you miss your time, you may come at a later time. We will post information about painting your spot at a later date. You must be clear of all holds, fines, fees, etc., to purchase parking for next year.

Parking at CRHS

Student parking will be all reserved spaces for the 2017-2018 school year. Each reserved space is \$75. Only seniors may personalize their space. **Sophomores will not be allowed to purchase a reserved space until the second 6 weeks of school; and then ONLY IF there are any reserved spaces available.** A reserved parking space must be purchased at least a day before a student is allowed to park on campus. Failure to follow parking guidelines will result in a boot fee and/or loss of parking privilege.

Spring Semester Exam – Extenuating Circumstances

Did you know that Cinco Ranch allows you to exempt a semester exam if you meet all of the requirements? But remember, regardless of whether an absence is excused or unexcused, it **WILL** count against exemptions.

Exemption cards will be distributed during all lunches on Thursday, May 18th and Friday, May 19th and you must have a current school ID to get yours.

If you believe you have an extenuating circumstance and wish to apply for an exception of 1 or 2 additional absences, you will need to fill out an extenuating circumstance form. These forms can be picked up in your grade level Principal's office and must be returned to your grade level Principal by Tuesday, May 16th. No forms will be accepted after the deadline.

LIBRARY MATERIALS--The last day to return any library materials and/or pay fines will be **Friday, May 12th**. If you have not cleared your account at that point, you will be placed on the final exam exemption hold list.

SENIORS:

Exemptions: Those of you who are able to exempt your finals, you do not have the week of finals off. You must attend all classes until that class exam is given. For example: If you are exempting 4th and 5th period, you must attend 4th and 5th period all week, until the Exam is given. If you miss these classes, you will be given an absence and could end up taking your finals. Be smart and attend classes like last semester. Pay attention to attendance requirements.

SENIOR GRADUATION SURVEY

ALL seniors **must** complete the KISD graduation survey. **This year it is on Naviance/Family Connection.** To complete the survey:

1. Using CHROME, go to mykatycloud. If Naviance tile is not there, search for Naviance which will establish the tile on the menu.
2. Log in to Naviance/Family Connection using KISD ID# and password (same as logging in to computer)
3. Click on "About Me" tab, then click on "graduation survey" and complete the survey.

**NOTE: This survey must be completed by all seniors. If you are unsure of how to answer some of the questions, complete it as best you can. You can go back and change/update answers if needed.

In ADDITION, if you have ANY fees or fines due, you will not be able to purchase a Prom Ticket until your outstanding fees have been paid.
