Volunteer Enrollment Option Guidelines

Athletics

1. As per UIL rules, there will be no recruiting/contacting of a student athlete who is not enrolled at the new campus.
2. For a student athlete who is volunteering to attend another high school, their first day of contact with a coach at the new high school can be no sooner than Thursday, April 1, 2010.
3. As per UIL rules, athletics cannot be the sole reason to volunteer to go to another high school.
4. Once the Volunteer Enrollment Option form is signed and submitted, the volunteer student cannot participate or try out for athletics at one campus while being enrolled at another campus.
5. After a student has submitted a Volunteer Enrollment Option form, he/she can still participate in athletics at their current school.
6. If there are any questions regarding UIL and Katy ISD athletic regulations as it pertains to the Volunteer Enrollment Option, contact the Executive Director of Athletics at 281-396-7781.

Fine Art Programs

1. There will be no recruiting/contacting of any fine arts student not enrolled at the new campus by any fine arts director/instructor (includes private lesson instructors).
2. For a fine arts student who is volunteering to attend another high school, their first day of contact with a director/instructor regarding the fine arts program at the new high school can be no sooner than Thursday, April 1, 2010.
3. Participation in a particular fine arts program cannot be the sole reason to volunteer to go to another high school.
4. Once the Volunteer Enrollment Option form is approved by the Student and Campus Support Services office, the volunteer student may try out for a position in a particular fine arts program at the new campus while still being enrolled at current campus.
5. If there are any questions regarding fine arts student's participation as it pertains to the Volunteer Enrollment Option, contact the Executive Director of Fine arts at 281-396-2270.

Cheerleading and Competitive Academic Teams

1. There will be no recruiting/contacting of any cheerleading or competitive academic team member not enrolled at the new campus by any sponsoring instructor.
2. For a cheerleader or competitive academic team member who is volunteering to attend another high school, their first day of contact with a sponsoring instructor regarding the program at the other high school can be no sooner than Thursday, April 1, 2010.
3. Participation in a particular cheerleading or competitive academic team program cannot be the sole reason to volunteer to go to another high school.
4. Once the Volunteer Enrollment Option form is approved by the Student and Campus Support Services office, the volunteer student may try out for a position in a cheerleading or competitive academic team program at the new campus while being enrolled at the current campus.
