Overview Senate Bill 9 now requires parents to opt-in instead of opting-out in public school instruction and materials regarding the prevention of child abuse, family violence, dating violence, and sex trafficking. This information is taught by the campus councilors. The topics will be posted on canvas and campuses will have a parent guide both opt-in & opt-out.

6TH, 7TH, 8TH grade - Building relationships healthy vs unhealthy relationships. Dating violence, family violence, human trafficking,
