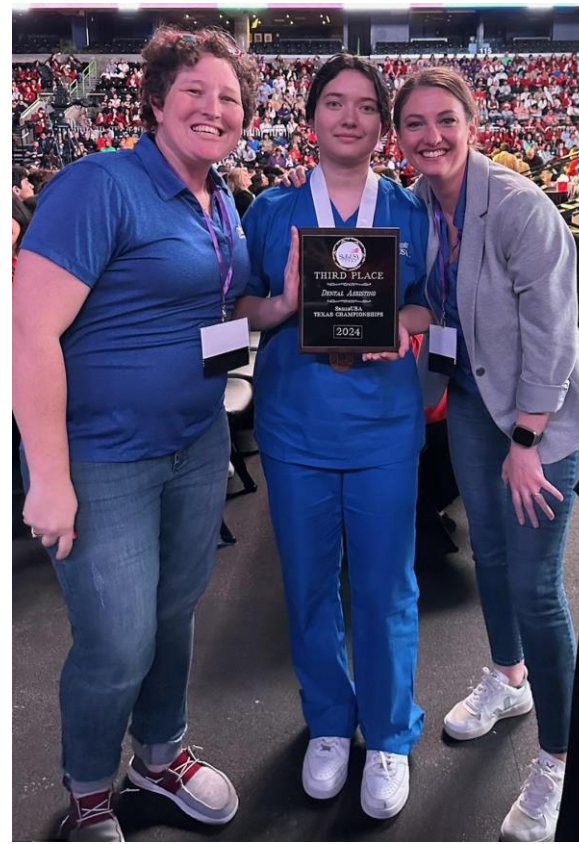

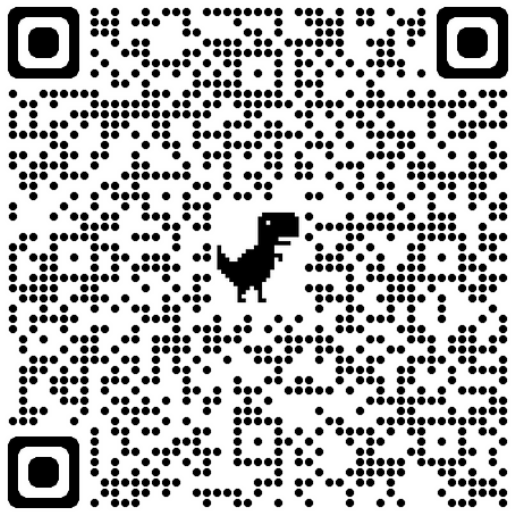

Laundry HACKS

Ink Stain

Scrub some toothpaste into it, let it dry, and then wash it. The stain will disappear.

Grease Stain

Rub some chalk into it and then wash it. It will come out good as new.

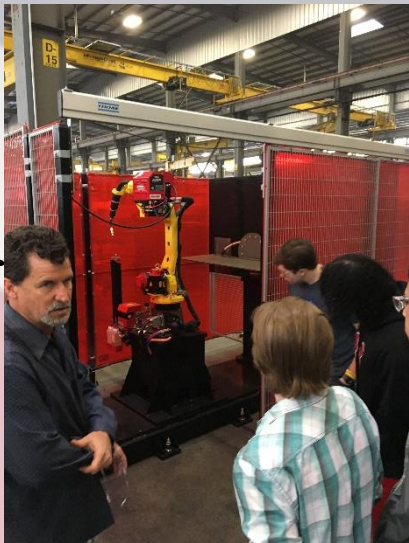
Blood Stain

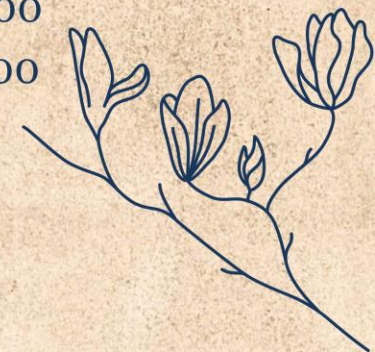
