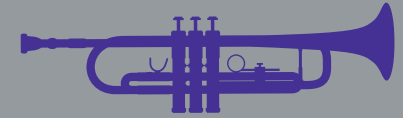

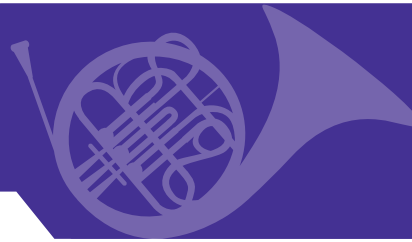

Requirements

Organization

Bands will be grouped by ability, through auditions, with the number of bands determined by enrollment.
