What do Katy ISD School-Business Partnerships **LOOK** Like?

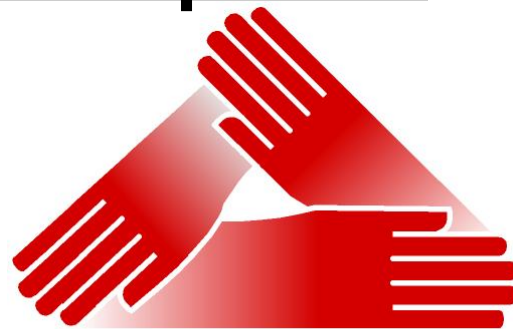
Katy ISD Partnerships are **long-term, reciprocal relationships** between a business and a campus.

★ **Campus partnerships are managed by the campus PIE liaison in cooperation with the Partners in Education department.**

★ **All partnerships begin with a Partnership Agreement negotiated by the business and campus PIE liaison.**

The Partnership Agreement outlines specific ways the school and business will support one another. Partnership Agreements can only be written by the Partners in Education department or a campus partnership liaison.

★ **The primary focus of all partnerships is on human resource involvement through Katy ISD programs like KEYS Mentoring, Junior Achievement, Promise to Read, Walk a Mile in My Shoes or other campus-specific activities.**

What does a Campus PIE Liaison Do?

In addition to their other campus responsibilities, campus liaisons manage partnerships by:

- ☑ Recruiting new business partners for the campus.
- ☑ Nurturing the relationship a campus has with existing business partners.
- ☑ Looking for ways to involve business partners on campus.
- ☑ Attending meetings with the PIE department to help coordinate partnerships district-wide.

Buy One, Get One Free

Percent Discounts

Dine-In Only

Purchase Required

Adult Purchase Required

Rebates, or

Reduced Rates

Advertisements, Flyers and Teacher Incentives?

Katy ISD cannot circulate flyers from for-profit organizations directly to students nor can we send the information to campus staff through teacher mailboxes, or by using the district's email system. Offers for teachers can be publicized by placing information in the teachers' lounge area, but only after receiving campus principal approval.
