



TIMELINE	ACTION	RATIONALE
July 20, 2020 – August 7, 2020	Katy Virtual Academy (KVA) registration is open	Per the Texas Education Agency (TEA), school districts are to offer students the option of in-person instruction or virtual instruction this school year.
August 3, 2020	PowerSchool snapcodes for annual student updates sent via email or US Postal to parents	As required annually, parents must log into Powerschool and update their student's information.
August 6, 2020	Technology Device Request Form available	Students in need of technology support to participate in virtual learning will be able to request devices and related needs.
August 7, 2020	Last day to revoke KVA registration for the first grading period	Teachers will be assigned to KVA classes based on the number of enrolled students. Schedules will be built out based on those numbers.
August 10, 2020	Professional learning sessions begin for teachers	Teachers and school personnel will engage in professional learning pertaining to instructional delivery and safety protocols for the Fall semester.
August 17, 2020	Elementary homeroom teacher assignments, and Secondary student schedules released	Parents and students will be able to access homeroom teacher assignments or class schedules via the Home Access Center (HAC).
August 17-18, 2020	Fall 2020 "Campus Grab and Go" distribution	Campuses* will distribute student IDs, requested technology devices, school supplies, and other new school year information. <i>*More communication on this will come from students' home campuses.</i>
August 19, 2020	First Day of School. Virtual learning for all students	Katy ISD will begin the school year with all students participating in virtual learning through September 7.
September 8, 2020	Campuses reopen for the in-person instructional option	Students who have elected KVA will continue with that program virtually. Those who have elected in-person instruction will report to their home campus.
