LEGACY GUEST GUIDELINES

Guests will enter Legacy Stadium 60 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony. At the request of the Fire Marshal and Katy ISD Legacy Stadium Officials, the following guidelines must be followed:

- Spectators will enter through the main gates. Graduates will enter through assigned gate.
- Do not block or stand in the aisles or on ramps to take pictures.
- Only Katy ISD approved photographers are permitted on the field.
- No signs larger than a poster board. No signs of any kind can be attached to the railings or walls.
- No helium balloons, air horns, and laser pointers permitted.
- No glass containers of any kind (including vases)
- No outside food/beverages. Concession stands will be open.

GRADUATION GUIDELINES

Campuses will have specific information and guidelines, to which all students must adhere, in order to walk at graduation. Enter Legacy Stadium through assigned gate. Gate assignments will be given when cap and gowns are handed out.

- Gowns should be ironed for your ceremony.
- Gowns should be carried, not worn into Legacy Stadium.
- Cap and gowns MUST be worn, fully zipped to walk in the graduation ceremony. Caps must be worn flat, parallel to the floor. No decorations on caps. Tassel is worn on the right side.
- Wear comfortable clothing, you will be outside. Wedge heeled shoes acceptable. Spiked heels not recommended on field as the surface is uneven.
- If a student violates discipline or dress code guidelines, the student will not participate in graduation ceremonies.
- Cords and cowls are worn during commencement ceremonies to exemplify academic excellence.
- Exemplary achievement medals may be worn when approved by the principal. The following criteria for cords, cowls, and medals have been established:

CORDS - High Honor graduates, Honor graduates, graduates completing 60 hours of confirmed community service through campus-sponsored service efforts, graduates who have earned a cord from a state, national or international organization for scholarship, service or leadership as approved by the principal, and senior members of the Superintendent's Student Roundtable.

COWLS - National Honor Society, senior class officers, valedictorian, and salutatorian only.

MEDALS - District-awarded medals for students who receive a KISD Award of Excellence, medals won for state or national-level awards (principal's approval required), or campus-awarded medals for students who have met campus-designated requirements (principal's approval required).
