

#### **Dress Code Procedures**

Dress Code resets each semester.

# Dress Code Consequence Warning One-hour Detention Two-hour Detention Four-hour Saturday Detention ISS for Non-Compliance

- Students will change into dress code clothes and receive a consequence.
  - o Students that refuse to change will be placed in ISS for the day.
- Return clothes by the end of 7<sup>th</sup> period.
- Missed Saturday detention results in lunch detentions until a Saturday detention is completed.
- Blankets and bonnets are also considered dress code violations.

### YOU MUST BE IN DRESS CODE WHEN YOU ENTER BUILDING

- Putting on a jacket does not fix the problem.
- All items (ex. hats, hoodies) will be confiscated and stored. This is your warning.

ISS for dress code will affect your exemption status for semester exams & PROM

### **ID Expectations**

- If you forget your ID, Correct the problem BEFORE first period.
   You will still be charged \$1 for the temporary ID.
- If students do not wear their ID around their neck with their school issued Lanyard — 2-hour detention & \$1 charge if temp ID is needed.
  - You MUST be wearing the correct color lanyard ONLY –
     This will result in 2 hour detention.
- Repeat offenders will receive additional consequences.
- Temporary ID will get in line last for cafeteria
- No collecting lanyards

#### **TARDIES**

- Excessive tardies will affect exemptions (5 or more denies ability to exempt the course)
- More than 15 min tardy = additional consequences
- Tardy after 25 minutes =
  Truancy and additional
  consequences

#### Tardy Procedures

Tardy count per six-week grading period

Tardies	Consequence
1-4	Warning
5-6	One-hour Detention
7-8	Two-hour Detention
9-10	Two-hour Saturday Detention
11-12	Four-Hour Saturday Detention
13+	Overnight Suspension

- Tardies following an Overnight Suspension meeting will be addressed as Non-Compliance.
- A missed Saturday detention will result in lunch detentions until a four-hour Saturday detention is completed.

### Credit and Absences

- Failure to attend class and/or school can result in loss of credit for that course/courses
- Even if you are passing the course, you must be present for credit to be received
- Attendance issues possibly can result in court appearances
- More than IO absences will result in credit loss
- Ex. 120 hours = 120 hours of Credit Restoration



### LATE ARRIVAL & EARLY RELEASE

LATE ARRIVAL- CANNOT ENTER BUILDING UNTIL 10 MIN PRIOR TO BELL RINGING

If not in HUB – Unauthorized Area

## SOCIAL MEDIA/CYBERBULLYING

- ANYTHING POSTED ONLINE NEVER DISAPPEARS
- ANY TYPE OF CYBERBULLYING THAT CAUSES A CAMPUS DISRUPTION WILL RECEIVE CONSEQUENCES



### CAMPUS CELL PHONE POLICY

- Cell phones are not allowed out during CLASSTIME for any reason
  - This includes the hallways during class, walking to restroom, nurse, etc.



PHONES TO BE PLACED INSIDE YOUR BACKPACK

### CAMPUS CELL PHONE POLICY

- First Offense Warning sign doc
- Second Offense Turn in phone to teacher start of each period
- Third Offense Give teacher phone, parent picks up, Turn phone into AP office EVERY Morning
  - 1 month, 1 six weeks, 1 semester

Any noncompliance to turn in phone will result in automatic jump to 3<sup>rd</sup> offense

### **CHROMEBOOKS**

#### **EXPECTATIONS:**

- BRING CHARGED EVERYDAY
- FOLLOW TEACHER EXPECTATION OF USE IN ROOM
- NO CHARGING PHONES IN CHROMEBOOK DURING CLASS
- NO STICKER DECALS ON CASE



### PHYSICAL ALTERCATIONS

- HAVING CONFLICT WITH ANOTHER STUDENT SEEK SUPPORT (TEACHER/COUNSELOR/AP)
- IF HIT BY ANOTHER STUDENT AVOID STRIKING BACK (ASSAULT)
- WHEN A STUDENT IS HIT BY ANOTHER STUDENT AND STRIKES
   BACK, THEY BECOME A PARTICIPANT IN THE EVENT SELF DEFENSE
   DOES NOT APPLY
- STUDENTS WHO ENGAGE IN A FIGHT = 3 DAYS OF ISS AND A REFERREL/TICKET TO HARRIS COUNTY COURT
- SECOND OFFENSE FIGHTS COULD RESULT IN OAC PLACEMENT

### PHYSICAL ALTERCATIONS

- Students who fight will be required to check into the small café every morning prior to the 7:08 bell to release to class
- Students who fight will be assigned a certain cafeteria for their lunch time
- Assignment will last the entire semester

### SELF DEFENSE

#### TO CLAIM SELF DEFENSE A STUDENT MUST:


- I. BE WITHOUT FAULT IN PROVOKING THE ENCOUNTER
- 2. NOT ACT AS AGGRESSOR
- 3. USE MINIMUM FORCE REQUIRED TO REMOVE THEMSELVES FROM IMMEDIATE DANGER/HARM




### POSSESSION

A STUDENT MUST BE CONSIDERED IN POSSESSION OF AN OBJECT OR SUBSTANCE IF THE ITEM IS:

- I. ON STUDENTS PERSON
- 2. IN STUDENTS PERSONAL PROPERTY (CLOTHING, PURSE, BACKPACK)
- 3. IN ANY SCHOOL PROPERTY USED BY THE STUDENT (DESK, LOCKER...)
- 4. IN ANY PRIVATE VEHICLE DRIVEN BY THE STUDENT TO SCHOOL OR SCHOOL SPONSORED EVENT.

### **Level 4 offense — Permissive DAEP**

- You may be sent to DAEP for engaging in the following conduct:
- Serious or persistent misbehavior
- Off-campus felonies
- Bullying that encourages suicide, incites violence or releases or threatens to release intimate visual material.
- Violating a Stay Away Agreement
- Engaging in fights
- Engaging in assaults
- Engaging in significant health or safety hazard
- Violating security and safety guidelines

### **After School Events At PHS**

Students must be picked up no later than 15 minutes after event ends.

- If you are picked up more than 30 minutes after event – loss of privileges for semester

### **After School Events At PHS**

Students who do not act appropriately at events that negatively affects the reputation of PHS will receive the following:


- Kicked out by Admin: No more events for rest of the year.

- Attend an event but in ISS, OSS, OAC or JJAEP. Trespassing ticket and no more events for a calendar year.


### **After School Events At PHS**





