January 27th - February 7th:
Course Selection Worksheet completed by student and returned to Science teacher.

February 2025
Counselors will meet with students individually to ensure their courses have been entered correctly.

March 3rd - 7th, 2025
Parents will have one final chance to look at your student's choices & inquire about changes.

REMEMBER: Course Selection is designed so that we can place your students in the classes that they want, but we must consider the BEST placement for them. What they choose may not be the final class that they are assigned, but we will do our best to honor their wishes and factor in any thing that will impact their learning (SPED, 504, etc.).




THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

KAP or NO KAP?
KAP is a more challenging course, fast-paced, and more homework.


PE or ATHLETICS?
PE is something that EVERYONE can take.
Athletics is aimed at students wanting to get stronger while playing sports. You can sign up, but remember all sports, except football will have tryouts. You MUST have a physical by the 10th day of school to remain in the class.

ELECTIVES:
Be sure to sign up for something that interests YOU. Don't be afraid to try something new! When you select your alternates, be sure to select courses that you would be okay taking, if your first choice didn't work.
