WHAT ARE MY SCHEDULING OPTIONS?

Select courses will be offered in a variety of formats to offer students flexibility and choice.

In addition to traditional face-to-face, some courses may be taken virtually as part of the instructional day, and some may still be taken virtually outside of the school day with a fee.



HOW CAN I TAKE A VIRTUAL COURSE?

As an 11th grader, you can select **two (2)** virtual course offering to be taken during the instructional day. **Both** of these courses could be connected to a Late Arrival or Early Release period.

Additionally, you can choose up to **two (2)** tuition-based virtual courses that are scheduled outside of the instructional day.



WHEN ARE VIRTUAL COURSES SCHEDULED?

Instructional Day (ID) Virtual Courses are scheduled in 3 ways within the 7 period day:

- with a **Study Hall**
- with a **Late Arrival***
- with an **Early Release***

**LATE ARRIVAL & EARLY RELEASE ARE FOR 10-12TH GRADE AND REQUIRE OWN TRANSPORTATION*

Tuition-Based Virtual Courses (formerly KVS) are scheduled outside of the Instructional Day.



WHICH COURSES ARE AVAILABLE VIRTUALLY?

Courses available to 11th graders for Instructional Day (ID) are:
