

# 2019-2020 Pre-Kindergarten Registration is April 16, 2019

## Katy Online Registration

Katy ISD will be using PowerSchool, an online registration process for new student registration. Online Registration can be access by visiting the following [www.katyisd.org/registration](http://www.katyisd.org/registration).

Parents of those students who may be eligible for Pre-kindergarten are encouraged to begin the online registration process on March 4, 2019.

### **Pre-Kindergarten classes will be held at the following campuses for 2019-2020:**

Spanish speaking classes will be held at Bear Creek, Campbell, Fielder, Franz, Hutsell, Jenks, King, McRoberts, Memorial Parkway, Morton Ranch, Rhoads, Schmalz, Stephens, Sundown and Williams.

English speaking classes will be held at Alexander, Bear Creek, Cimarron, Creech, Exley, Franz, Golbow, Griffin, Hayes, Holland, Katy, Kilpatrick, King, Mayde Creek, McRoberts, Memorial Parkway, Morton Ranch, Rhoads, Rylander, Stephens, Sundown, West Memorial, and Winborn.

Pre-Kindergarten registration for the 2019-2020 school year for children in Katy ISD will take place on **April 16, 2019**. Contact the registration site for times. Parents must register their child at the elementary school that the child is zoned to attend **with these exceptions:**

- Students zoned to Wolfe will register at **Bear Creek**.
- Students zoned to Randolph, Davidson, Stanley, Shafer, Wilson, and Wolman will register at **Griffin**.
- Students zoned to Bryant will register at **Katy**.
- Students zoned to Bethke will register at **King**.
- Students zoned to Pattison will register at **Hayes**.
- Students zoned to Nottingham Country will register at **Memorial Parkway**.
- Students zoned to WoodCreek will register at **Rylander**.
- Students zoned to Elementary #42 will register at **Morton Ranch**.

To qualify for the pre-kindergarten program, the child must reside in Katy ISD and be **four years old on or before Sept. 1, 2019**. The child must also meet one of the following qualifications:

- Limited English proficient because a language other than English is the primary language spoken in the home. Students qualifying by language will be tested on the day of registration to determine placement in the program.
- Qualify according to the Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines. Parents must bring proof of income of all persons employed within the home (documentation for at least **one month of income**). Proof of income can include current check stubs, child support statement of payment, SNAP qualification letter, etc.
- The family is homeless.
- Have a parent who is an active member of the armed forces. Parent must present their Department of Defense photo identification (military ID). An active member of the Texas National Guard must provide a "Statement of Service" document.

- The child is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services. A letter from DFPS must be provided.
- Is the child of a person eligible for the Star of Texas Award as follows:
  - a peace officer under Section 3106.002, Government Code; or
  - a firefighter under Section 3106.003, Government Code; or
  - an emergency medical first responder under Section 3106.004, Government Code.

On the day of registration, parents must provide immunization records, a birth certificate, social security number, if available, proof of residency in Katy ISD (a home or apartment lease agreement, a recently paid utility bill with correct name and Katy ISD address of parent or guardian, or a letter from a mortgage company indicating approval of permanent financing for a residence in Katy ISD), and guardianship papers if the child resides with someone other than a parent.

Immunization records must be certified by a doctor or public health official and include the month, date and year of the immunizations. For specific information regarding immunization, please visit the [Health Services website](#).

**Program Information:**

Our Pre-kindergarten program follows the state guidelines set for Pre-k which focus on oral language development, reading and math readiness, as well as developing science and social studies knowledge and skills.

All students are given a pre/mid/post assessment of basic skills. Report cards are marked for social and academic skills for the first, second, third and fourth grading period. A parent conference will be scheduled during the fall semester. Other conferences may be held at parent and/or teacher request.

**Pre-Kindergarten Enrollment and School Attendance:**

**Parents or guardians must provide transportation to and from school.**

Pre-kindergarten is not a mandatory program. However, if your child qualifies and is enrolled, he/she is subject to compulsory attendance law. Your child must attend school each day, Monday through Friday.
