Dear Parent or Guardian,

Your child _____ is going home from school today with symptoms of illness. KISD Administrative Regulation FFAD is in place to ensure the health and safety of all students and states that students who exhibit vomiting, diarrhea, or a fever ≥ 100 , must be excluded from school.

Re admittance is allowable as follows:

- **Free of fever (<100) for at least 24 hours without** the use of fever-reducing medications such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen. Common trade names of products containing these medications include, but are not limited to Tylenol, Motrin and Advil. All aspirin-containing products should be avoided.
- Students who experience the symptoms of COVID-19 must stay at home throughout the infection period, and cannot return to campus until the **campus nurse screens** the individual to determine any of the below conditions for campus re-entry are met:
 - 24 hours have passed since recovery (no fever, no fever reducing medication); and
 - Improvement in symptoms; and
 - At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.

NOTE: A student who has symptoms that could be COVID-19, but is not evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, will need to be assumed to have COVID-19. The student will not be able to return to the campus until the student has completed the same three step criteria listed above and cleared by the campus nurse for re-entry. A student who wants to return to school before completing the conditions listed above for staying at home must either submit a medical professional note clearing the student on an alternative diagnosis OR negative COVID-19 test result at an approved testing location. Documentation must be submitted to the campus nurse for school re-entry clearance.

- **Food and liquids have been tolerated for at least 24 hours without** vomiting and/or diarrhea, and without the use of medication to relieve symptoms.
- **Students diagnosed with a contagious illness** that is being treated with prescription medication, must complete a minimum of 24 hours of the prescribed medication dosage prior to returning to school.

If the guidelines indicated above have been met, your child must report to the Campus Nurse for school re-entry.
