





<p>Sora</p>		<p>Sora contains fiction and nonfiction e-books and audiobooks in both English and Spanish. There are over 2,000 titles for elementary students. Students can borrow a book for up to 2 weeks.</p>
<p>Destiny Discover</p>		<p>Destiny Discover is the Katy ISD library management system. It contains titles of books in the library, as well as e-books and audiobooks.</p>
<p>Tumblebooks</p>		<p>Tumblebooks includes a variety of picture books, chapter books, graphic novels, songs, and more which are all read aloud to students.</p>
<p>Tumblebooks Spanish</p>		<p>These Tumblebook titles are all written and read aloud in Spanish.</p>
<p>Kids InfoBits</p>		<p>Kids InfoBits offers a wide-range of content for research. Topics include social studies, science, biographies, sports, animals, plants, and more.</p>
<p>Brain Pop Jr.</p>		<p>Brain Pop Jr offers videos on a variety of topics such as reading and writing, science, social studies, health, arts and technology, and math.</p>
<p>World Book Kids & World Book Espanol</p>		<p>An online encyclopedia that offers articles, reference materials, and videos for elementary students.</p>

Britannica School		An up-to-date, age appropriate, and safe information resource for elementary students.
Britannica Espanol		The same great Britannica resources but in Spanish.
Pebble Go		A great resource for PK-2 nd grade on a variety of topics such animals, science topics, biographies, social studies, and dinosaurs. Articles and videos are in both English and Spanish.
Pebble Go Next		A great resource for 3-5 th grade on science and social studies topics.
Maps 101		Maps 101 includes reference and interactive maps, as well as a reference atlas, and more, as well as resources in Spanish.
Texas Handbook		Information on the history of Texas. Also includes information about cities, rivers, and natural resources of Texas.
National Geographic Kids		Hundreds of National Geographic magazines, books, and videos on a variety of topics that are age appropriate and fun to use.
Discovery Education		Hundreds of videos and articles about news and current events, virtual field trips, and more on a wide-range of topics.





