Late Work Procedures 2020-21

Late Work Beliefs:

Meeting deadlines is a skill that will prepare students for both high school and the real world. These policies are not designed to hurt students but to hold them accountable for completing quality work and handing work in on time. At Stockdick Junior High, we encourage students to submit all given assignments by the due date to receive full credit.

Minor & Other Grades:

- If a student chooses to hand in work after the due date, it should be uploaded to Canvas, and 15 points will be subtracted from the assignment.
- For minor grades only, a student can choose to open the lines of communication and take ownership of their behavior, either in person or digitally, and will recuperate 5 points. In this time of uncertainty, we are committed to providing methods for students to own mistakes, ask for help, and work to improve their behavior.
- All missing work for a particular unit is due by two (2) days prior to that unit assessment for progress reports and report cards. Any work not received by that time will default to a zero in the gradebook.

Major Grades Retest/Redo Policy:

- Only students who have earned a test score of 74 or below have the option to retest/redo to earn a maximum score of 75.
- Students will have one week to retest/redo from the time they receive their original test grade.
- Students will have one opportunity to retest/redo.
- The student electing to retest/redo must attend a reteach/tutoring session prior to the retest/redo.
- The retest/redo will consist of an assessment that is different from the original but measures mastery of the same content.
- Teachers will notify parents of students who have earned the retest/redo option.
- Test corrections will not be submitted in lieu of another, minor or major grade.
- Teachers must notify the parent and case manager if a student scores below a 70 on a major assessment.
