



SLHS Fall 2020 Exemption Process



Exam Exemption Requirements

1. Must have a course average of a 70 or above.
2. You may not exempt a course in which you have an N in conduct
 - a. For example, having four tardies or more to one class makes you ineligible for that exemption.
3. You may not exempt any course if you have a U in conduct in any class
 - a. For example, having eight or more tardies to one class equals a “U” in conduct which would cause a student to lose all exemptions for the semester

Exam Exemption Requirements

1. You may not exempt if you have any Level 2, 3, 4, or 5 offenses that result in more than a combined total of six hours of any type of detention or any ISS or OSS or higher consequences
2. You may not exempt if you owe any fines or fees
3. With the exception of seniors, you cannot exempt the same class both semesters. Your fall semester exam exemption(s) must be different than your spring semester exam exemption(s).
4. You and your parents will be notified before December 8th if you are not eligible for exemptions due to disciplinary reasons.

What has changed?

For the Fall of 2020, the exemption component of absences has changed. Students are allowed to exempt with multiple absences as long as your average is above a 70 in the course.

However, if you are a student who has not been in attendance for 90% of the semester and you are on an Attendance for Credit plan with your Assistant Principal, then you are not eligible. You either have been notified or will be notified if this applies to you.

Absences due to Covid 19 illness or quarantine do not apply towards the 90% rule.

How Many Exams Can I Exempt?

Freshmen-one exam

Sophomores-two exams

Juniors-three exams

Seniors-all exams for both the Fall and Spring semester

Timeline

November 30th-December 4th: All students must pay all fines, fees, and holds in order to be eligible to exempt any final exams.

December 8th-10th: online submission of your final exam exemption choices through CANVAS. Each student will submit their exemption choices through Canvas.

December 8th-10th: in addition to submitting online, you must also notify your teacher that you are planning to exempt the final exam in that particular class.

All information will be repeated through your grade level Remind account, so if you are not on Remind, visit your grade level office.

Advanced Placement Courses

- Students who are enrolled in an AP Course and take the AP Exam for that course will be eligible for a final exam exemption for that course in the spring semester. This exemption will be granted in addition to the number of exemptions allowed per grade level.
- To be eligible, the student must sit for the corresponding AP Exam and meet all other grade, attendance, and behavior requirements for the exemption.

Advanced Placement Courses

- Students who exempt a Spring final exam by taking the corresponding AP Exam may also exempt this final exam in the fall semester. However, the fall semester exam exemption counts as one of the total exemptions per grade level.
- Note-HCC Dual Credit courses cannot be exempted.
