After School Assignment Hall 2019-2020

- Assignment Hall is held on Thursday in 100AB (Back of Main Commons).
- Students must enter the Assignment Hall by 2:45pm and complete the work which is past due for their class(es) unless other arrangements are made in advance.
- Students will show their incomplete/missing assignment to the supervising administrator, work on their assignment and once completed, the supervising administrator will sign off and collect the assignment.
- The supervising administrator will place the work in the appropriate teacher's mailbox.
- No late bus transportation will be provided.
- Students are responsible for all their own supplies, etc.
- Assignment Hall has an open door policy; students do not need to be assigned by a teacher to attend.
- Students may also use assignment hall for retesting, as assigned by a teacher.

Program Details

- Program is for all grades and levels of instruction.
- Assignments that are more than 5 instructional days past due may be accepted at the teacher's discretion.
- The maximum grade for an assignment, completed to standards as directed and turned in through the Assignment Hall, will be a 70.
- All in class and/or homework assignments may be completed in the Assignment Hall.
- Past due assignments from the last week of a grading period are due to the teacher by the last day of a grading period.
