

# Joining WebEx Meetings

## Join a WebEx Meeting from a Chromebook

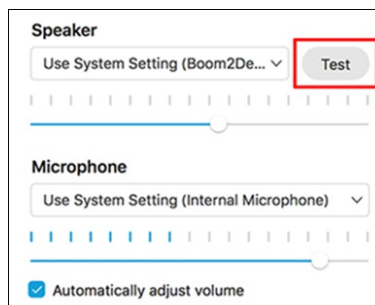
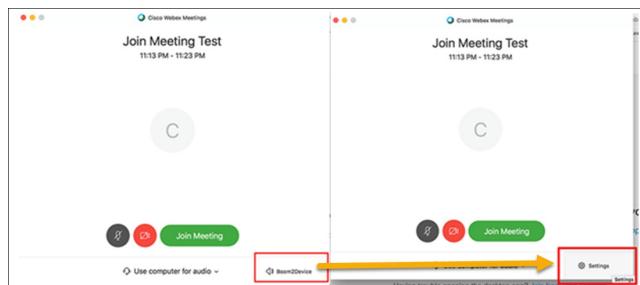
To join a WebEx meeting from a Chromebook, you will need to install the WebEx Meetings Extension.

1. Go to the Chrome Web Store by swiping up at the bottom of your screen
2. Search for **Cisco WebEx Extension** and install the extension by clicking **Add to Chrome**.
3. Click **Join** in your email invitation. *Your computer may still have to automatically download and install a WebEx add-on file when you first join a meeting.*
4. Enter your **Name and Email address** can click **Next**.
5. Enter the meeting password if there is one and click **Next**.
6. Click **Show me what's new** for a quick tour or select **Skip**.
7. You will then see a video preview of how you'll look to others.
8. **Change your audio and video settings** before joining your meeting.

## Test a Meeting on Your Device

To test your settings before joining a meeting, you can either start a meeting in your personal meeting room or join Cisco's test meeting at <https://www.webex.com/test-meeting.html>.

1. Enter your name and email address and click **Join**.
2. Once you've joined, test your audio settings:
  - Hover over the speaker name in the bottom right corner and it will turn into **Settings**
  - Click on **Settings**
3. Test your speakers:
  - Click the **Test** button, if you hear the five WebEx notes, you will be able to hear other people in the meeting.



4. Test your microphone:

- Speak in a normal voice and you should see the level of the mic jump up and down accordingly. If you don't, try moving the **slider** to the right to increase your volume going out. Also, click the **drop-down** menu and if there is a different mic option, choose it and see if that fixes the problem.
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## App Limitations

The Cisco Webex app for Chrome is a Chrome-specific app and provides the same ability to join a meeting through the browser as the Cisco Webex web app. It is available for download in the [Chrome Web Store](#). Using the Cisco Webex app for Chrome, attendees can join meetings directly in their browser by entering the meeting number.

### The following limitations apply:

- Limited to attendees only. Hosts must use the Webex Web App or the desktop app.
- Attendees can only join Cisco Webex Meetings on sites running WBS30 or higher.
- Does not support the Cisco Webex Meetings product meetings.webex.com.
- Attendees cannot join meetings with end-to-end encryption enabled.
- Attendees cannot join meetings on the "VoIP-only" site type.
- Does not support content sharing
