

# Instructions for Course Request Verification Rising 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students 2023-2024

**Please note:** This is not a schedule, this is a list of requested courses.

- **Please check for 6 classes.** Each student should have English/Reading Block, Math, Science, Social Studies, PE, and one elective. If any classes are missing, write them in and include the level (academic or KAP) if necessary.

Katy ISD continues to have an open enrollment policy in place for students who wish to participate in advanced academics level courses called Katy Advanced Placement (KAP). KAP level classes are designed to challenge students beyond grade-level academic courses and prepare them for success in future advanced coursework. These classes offer a more rigorous and in-depth content focus than the academic course, often move at a faster pace, and include different types of assignments, and require additional outside reading.

**\*Students who score “Masters” level on 5<sup>th</sup> grade state exams, will be automatically placed in the corresponding KAP course if they have not already requested the course.** Please use the table provided below as a tool to support this enrollment.

If the students achieves “Masters” level on:	The student will be eligible for:
5 <sup>th</sup> grade state exam Reading	English Language Arts and Reading Block 6 KAP <b>and</b> Social Studies 6 KAP
5 <sup>th</sup> grade state exam Math	Math 6 KAP
5 <sup>th</sup> grade state exam Science	Science 6 KAP

- Off Campus PE Applications
  - Junior High campuses will accept applications beginning August 1, 2023. Applications will not be accepted prior to this date.
- State Mandated Intervention
  - Strategic Reading and Math Lab are interventions course that may be required for students who did not perform successfully on state exams and/or based upon documented reading and/or math levels. These courses will take the place of the student’s PE or elective.
