

# **COURSE SELECTION PROCESS**


2023-2024 School Year

changes.

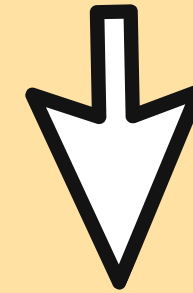
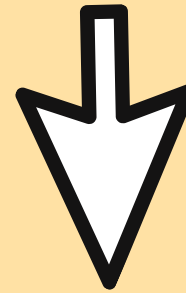
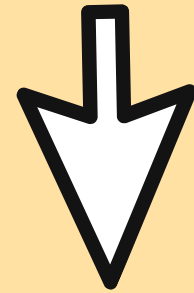
REMEMBER: Course Selection is designed so

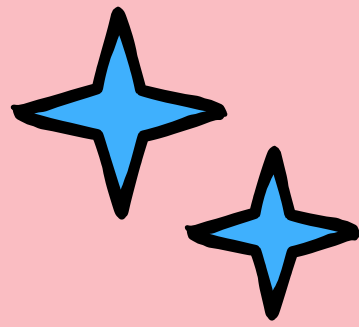

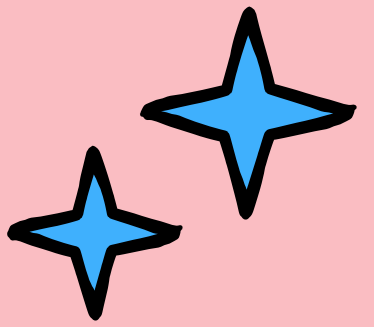

### KAP or NO KAP?


KAP is a more challenging course, fast-paced, and more homework.

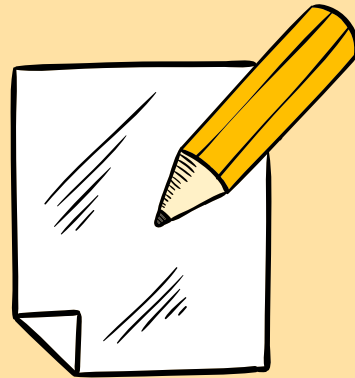
### ELECTIVES:
