Students may not receive their first choice elective due to insufficient enrollment in a course, scheduling conflict, or over enrollment in course. Final placement into courses is contingent upon campus approval. GT placement requires the student to have met specific Katy ISD screening criteria.

Dear Parent/Guardian,
Course selection for the upcoming 2025-26 school year has begun. Important dates for course selection are listed below.

February 3, 2025-March 18, Students select courses in SchoolLinks using Course Planner

February 10, 2025 Counselors will begin meeting with students individually to review course requests

Until March 18, 2025 Course Verification – Parents verify courses and request course changes

Students received information about all required and elective courses that are available to them for the next school year. Now students need to make informed choices about courses that will best meet his or her educational needs.

There are different formats for the core courses from which to choose:

- Academic** - on grade level and designed to prepare students for high school and college
 - KAP (Katy Advanced Placement)** - prepare students for Advanced Placement courses (college level instruction) while in high school
 - KAP/G/T (Gifted and Talented)** - placement requires the student to have met specific KISD screening criteria and have been
- Katy ISD has an open enrollment policy for advanced academics. Early enrollment in these courses contributes to student achievement in later years. KAP courses

If your student changes his/her mind about course selections after March 21, your child will have an opportunity to request changes to their selections.
