What are CTE Courses?

CTE (Career & Technical Education) courses help prepare you for college and careers by providing hands-on learning and industry-relevant skills. These courses are grouped into Programs of Study based on career interests like health science, engineering, agriculture, information technology, and more.


Step-by-Step Guide to Enroll in CTE Courses

1. Log into SchoolLinks

- Go to MyKatyCloud and login
- Select the SchoolLinks logo


2. Review Your Program of Study

- In SchoolLinks, click on the “Programs of Study” section
- Browse the available career pathways
- Select the Program of Study that best matches your interests and career goals

 This area will show you the sequence of CTE courses recommended for your chosen program—from entry-level to advanced.

3. Start Course Selection

- During the course selection window, go to the Course Planner or Course Selection tool in SchoolLinks
- Search for and select the next appropriate course in your Program of Study
 - Example: If you completed “Principles of Health Science,” your next course will be “Medical Terminology”

 Be sure to follow the course sequence as listed in your Program of Study to stay on track and earn CTE endorsements or certifications.

4. Talk to Your Counselor (if needed)

- Considering changing your Program of Study?
