- Select the Program of Study that best matches your interests and career goals

3. Start Course Selection

- During the course selection window, go to the Course Planner or Course Selection tool in SchooLinks
- Search for and select the next appropriate course in your Program of Study
- Example: If you completed "Principles of Health Science," your next course will be "Medical Terminology"
- Be sure to follow the course sequence as listed in your Program of Study to stay on track and earn CTE endorsements or certifications.
