

# GT Info

Once your child is GT, there is no need to retest if the student remains in the Katy ISD school district. Exceptions: Furlough and Exit

## **Exit Criteria for GT Classes**

A student may permanently exit the program at parent's request. Exit decisions may come from the GT Campus Selection Committee. The criteria outlined in the secondary GT exit procedure allow a student the opportunity to be put on review status while working through a contract to achieve success in the program -Growth Plan.

The Campus Selection Committee will consider multiple criteria when determining the need for an exit.

Students who self-select out of GT course options at any time will be exited from that subject area.

Furloughs due to schedule conflicts will be considered for a maximum of one year per subject area.



## **GT** Info

Students in Gifted and Talented are expected to choose KAP (Katy Academic Program), Dual Credit, or Advanced Placement courses in their area of giftedness. (They may choose more!)

NEW: Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students may take World Geography KAP and/or World History KAP over the summer and NOT be exited from the Gifted and Talented program.

## **GT** Info

GT students must enroll in an Advanced Placement level course for the 2025-2026 fall and spring semesters

Please note that World Geography KAP GT and World History KAP GT are ONLY an option over the summer. AP Human Geography or World History AP are the expected placement for GT students during the school year.

## Reminder

Students may not take both AP Human Geography (2 semesters/1 credit course) and World Geography Academic or World Geography KAP

Students may not earn credit for both the AP Human Geography (0347/0348) and AP Human Geography (0345). **Note:** One course is a two semester course and the other course is a semester course.

# Grade Point Average

Only High School Credit courses count in your child's Grade Point Average-GPA. Beginning with the Class of 2029, junior high Algebra 1 will not factor into the student's GPA (Grade Point Average) if the student successfully completes 4 additional credits of high school math.
