- No re-test option for final exams
- Must take exams in Dual Credit courses
- Exams begin on Tuesday, December 13th

### What are exemptions?

- It is a reward for students meeting certain requirements.
  - Behavior, Attendance, Grades, etc.

 It means you do not have to take the final exam and your semester grade will be calculated using your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd 6 weeks' averages.

## **Exemption Requirements**

- Behavior
  - No ISS / OSS
  - Conduct grades of "Satisfactory" or "Excellent"
    - Conduct grade of "N" = cannot exempt that class
    - Conduct grade of "U" =- cannot exempt any class
- Attendance- cannot fall below 90% attendance
- Grades- 80% or higher

### How many classes can I exempt?

9th Grade	10th Grade	11th Grade	12th Grade
1 exemption	2 exemptions	3 exemptions	7 exemptions
9th - 11th grade: cannot exempt same			

class in fall **and** spring, except AP courses

## How do I figure out what to exempt? Be smart.


	1st 6W	2nd 6W	3rd 6W	Final??
Class #1	93%	88%	89%	Your average is a 90% before exam. If you get below 90% on the final, you will not maintain an "A."
Class #2	85%	80%	76%	Your average is an 80%. You need a 76% on final to maintain a "B."



#### Exam Exemption Criteria

Submission does not guarantee approval. Requests will be reviewed, and an email notification will be sent to the student and parent email address on file.

#### Students may earn a specific course exemption by meeting the following requirements within that specific course:

- Earned a semester course average of 80-100
- · Earned a S or higher conduct grade within the course
- \* Student does not owe any course fees or fines
- Student meets campus specific requirements related to exemption submission deadlines and verification procedures for securing their exemptions.
- . Student did not exceed more than (8) absences within the course.
- 1. Please note: Students who fall below the 90% attendance rule (more than 8 absences) will be required to sit for a final exam as part of their Attendance for Credit Plan.
- (College visits are included in the 8 absences)
- 2. Please note: The following absence codes do NOT count toward the 8 allowable excused & unexcused absences:
- i. P: Present but not in class
- ii. S: School-sponsored curricular and extra-curricular activity that is not UIL related
- iii. V: UIL and other competitive activity

#### Students are eligible for the following number of final exam exemptions:

- Ninth Grade: (1) Final Exam Exemption
- . Tenth Grade: (2) Final Exam Exemptions
- Eleventh Grade: (3) Final Exam Exemptions
- Seniors: May exempt ALL final exams, if eligible, during the fall and spring semester.

#### Final Exam Exemption Clarifications:

Except for seniors, students may not exempt the same course final for both the fall and spring semesters.

#### Advanced Placement (AP) Exams:

Students enrolled in an AP course and successfully sit for the AP exam for that course may elect to exempt the final exam in the Spring semester. The final exam exemption in which the student successfully takes the AP exam does not count toward the maximum number of exemptions for that student's grade level
