What is Student Council/SOS?

Student Council and Spartans Out Serving (SOS) is the organization that is mostly run by students in an effort to create a community like environment on campus. Students plan and attend events, create positive posters, spread awareness of drugs, alcohol and safety plans, and promote volunteering in the local community.

How do I join Student Council?

Any student at SLHS can register for Student Council by filling out the information and paying the \$20 dues on the Katy ISD PayNGo App. Once both have been completed, students will be added to the SLHS Student Council Canvas Course.

How do I get involved?

General members participate in Student Council meetings and projects. General members have the option of choosing to follow the Participation track, the SOS track or both! Students may participate in as many projects and activities as they desire.
