

### 2023-24 Jordan High School AP Exam Information

#### FALL REGISTRATION

Registration and payments **begin on September 25, 2023** at 7:00 a.m. and **end on October 25, 2023** at 7:00 p.m. Students who are enrolled in an AP class during the Fall semester **MUST** register and submit payment to take AP exams by the deadline on October 25<sup>th</sup>. This includes Miller, approved homeschool, KVS, Summer KVS, and independent study students.

#### SPRING REGISTRATION

Registration and payments for Spring semester only classes **begin on January 14, 2024** at 7:00 a.m. and **end on February 14, 2024** at 7:00 p.m. Students who are enrolled in a Spring semester only AP class **MUST** register and make payment to take exams by the deadline on February 14, 2024. This includes Miller, approved homeschool, KVS, Summer KVS, and independent study students. All registration will end February 14, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.

#### LATE REGISTRATION

Students may not register for exams after the October 25<sup>rd</sup> deadline until the designated Late Registration period. Late Registration for full-year classes begins on **January 14, 2024** at 7:00 a.m. and **ends on February 14, 2024** at 7:00 p.m. Students who were enrolled in a full-year AP class during the Fall registration period may complete Late Registration during this time for an additional **\$40 late fee per exam**. All registrations will end on February 14, 2024 at 7:00 p.m.

#### Cost

\$102 per AP Exam (includes a \$4 Total Registration processing fee per exam) and \$152 for AP Seminar and AP Research Exams (includes a \$6 Total Registration processing fee per exam). You may make a partial minimum payment of \$40 per exam plus Total Registration fees by October 25, 2024, 7:00 p.m. The final balance for all exams must be made by February 14, 2024. **Failure to pay in full will result in a cancelled test.** Payments are submitted within Total Registration for ALL AP College Board exams at TotalRegistration.net/AP/440553

### FREE/REDUCED INFORMATION

Students on the current Free/Reduced Lunch list may apply for fee waivers during the exam registration process to reduce the cost of their exams. \*\*This is marked by the student within Total Registration.\*\* His/her registration will be put on hold in Total Registration until the request for a fee waiver is verified. The fee will be \$25 per exam for Free/Reduced Lunch registration (\$75 per AP Seminar and AP Research exams). Students in special economic circumstances (Free and Reduced Lunch) MUST identify that need during the registration window. All requests for fee waivers must be made during the registration period for the exams to ensure proper arrangements are made for the student.

#### REFUNDS

No refunds will be given after the registration deadline.

#### **EXAM SCHEDULE**

AP Exams are scheduled for the weeks of May 6<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> and May 13<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup>. The campus will determine the most appropriate schedule to accommodate any exam conflicts. Alternate exams are administered May 22<sup>nd</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> for overlapping conflict exams determined by the campus.



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#### ACCOMMODATIONS

Students in need of testing accommodations must adhere to the College Board timeline for these requests. Firm College Board deadline before: January 17, 2024. Jordan HS requests that you submit accommodation requests to the SSD Coordinator, Melanie Piche, by January 11, 2024 at 2:00pm in order to allow time to process all documentation. Accommodation requests and, when required, complete documentation, must be submitted to Melanie Piche,

MelaniePPiche@katyisd.org 281-234-8935, no later than January 11, 2024, so that orders can be made for specific accommodation needs.

Accommodations will not be available to the student during testing if requests, and when required, complete documentation, are not submitted to Melanie Piche by January 11, 2024.

#### **AP EXAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

- Register and pay for AP Exams online at <a href="https://user.totalregistration.net/AP/440553">https://user.totalregistration.net/AP/440553</a>
- Make sure you have joined the class section on the College Board website prior to registering.
- Students who are taking an exam only and have not participated in an AP class either on campus, via Miller, or through KVS will need to email Ms. Ballard (Eng/SS/Art) or Ms. Paulson (Math/Sci/LOTE) for a join code for "Exam Only."
- Each student must use his/her own email address. Siblings may not share an email address. Important AP Exam information will be sent to the address provided.
- Answer all questions—choose and mark the correct exam.
- Have your debit or credit card ready when you register.
- Registration is not complete until payment is made, and the confirmation PDF is printed.
- No registrations will be accepted after the deadline.

#### **Notes**

- Students enrolled in AP classes are strongly encouraged, but not required, to participate in AP Exams. The exam has no bearing on your high school course grade.
- By State law, scores of 3, 4, or 5 on AP exams are accepted for credit at Texas public colleges and universities. Other institutions have their own policy on awarding college credit or advanced standing.
- Schools won't receive printed copies of the "Bulletin for AP Students and Parents." All information for students and parents is provided online.
- For general information about AP, students can go to <u>apstudents.org</u>.
- A "yes" clicked for student exam decision indicator within the College Board account does not mean a test is ordered. The only way an AP test is ordered is if payment for the AP test has cleared within Total Registration.
