## Dear Parent/Guardian,

Course selection for the upcoming 2024-2025 school year has begun. Important dates for course selection are listed below:

Janaury 31st	Course selection sheets will be sent home.		
February 9th	Students will return copy of their completed course selection sheet to their RLA teacher.		
February 5 - 19	Students select courses in SchooLinks using Course Planner, counselor meetings with students begin.		
February 8 - 9	Students will go to lab with counselor to input courses in SchooLinks, using their course selection sheet as a guide.		
February 20, 2024 @ 11:59 pm	Course Planner becomes "viewable only." in SchooLinks		
February 5 – March 8	Counselors meet with students individually to review course requests		
March 18 – March 26	Course Verification – Parents verify courses and request course changes in SchooLinks		

Students received information about all required and elective courses that are available to them for the next school year. Now students need to make informed choices about courses that will best meet his or her educational needs.

There are different formats for the core courses from which to choose:

- Academic on grade level and designed to prepare students for high school and college
- KAP (Katy Advanced Placement) prepare students for Advanced Placement courses (college level instruction) while in high school
- KAP/G/T (Gifted and Talented) placement requires the student to have met specific KISD screening criteria and have been accepted into the G/T program

Katy ISD has an open enrollment policy for advanced academics. Early enrollment in these courses contributes to student achievement in later years. KAP courses are designed to challenge students beyond grade-level academic courses and prepare them for success in future advanced level coursework. Students may require encouragement and support from both family and campus to be successful in advanced academics. Please review your child's report card and test scores in making course level decisions. Please note that students often enrolling a combination of course formats. Consider each course separately when deciding to select Academic or KAP.

If your student changes his/her mind about course selections after February 19, your child will have an opportunity to request changes to their selections during Course Verification during the week of March 18-26, 2024.

## Katy ISD Policy for Dropping High School Credit Courses

End of 1st Six Weeks: Any student with a failing grade will automatically be removed from the HS credit class & the grade <u>WILL NOT</u> be recorded on the HS transcript/GPA.

## • The ONLY time a student can request to exit a HS credit course is during the 1st six weeks!

- End of the 2nd Six Weeks: Any student with a failing grade will automatically be removed from the HS credit class & the grade will not be recorded on the HS transcript/GPA.
  - This is the last time an automatic drop will occur until the end of the 1st semester.
- 3rd Six Weeks: Any student that is failing during this time will remain in the class until the end of the semester. The teacher will work
  with the student to bring their grade up.
- End of 1st Semester: Any student that ends the 1st semester with a failing grade will be removed from the class and the grade <u>WILL BE</u> recorded on the HS transcript/GPA.
- NO drops will occur any time during the 2nd semester!
