



Dear Jordan High School Students and Parents,

AP testing starts on Monday, May 5th. As you prepare for your exams, we want to make you aware of a few things to ensure a smooth testing process. Please review this information carefully before testing so you can be prepared and do your best on your AP exam(s).

What to bring on exam day:

- Several #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils), blue or black pens, and approved <u>calculator</u> (if <u>applicable for your test</u>). School-issued calculators will be available for students in the exam room on test day for all exams that allow a calculator. The Desmos calculator is enabled in Bluebook for all sections which allow calculator use.
- Student ID (school or government issued, with photo) for each exam. Mandatory, no exceptions.
- Fully charged school issued Chromebook and charger. Portable chargers are encouraged. If you do not bring your charged Chromebook, you will not be allowed to test. Testing on personal devices will not be permitted.
- Snack and/or water for designated break (cannot eat/drink during exam).
- Dress in layers and bring a jacket.
- Students are encouraged to bring a sack lunch on the day of testing, especially if taking both the morning and afternoon exams on the same day, as students will have to eat quickly between exams and will not have time to go to the lunchroom.
 - Morning testers will receive instructions upon finishing their exams about which class and/or lunch to attend.
 - All afternoon testers will eat during "A" lunch, then after finishing lunch, report to the main gym if testing in the gym or rotunda learning stairs if testing in the LGI.

Other important information:

- Students will need to notify their parents, coaches, directors, employers, etc. that afternoon exams go beyond the end of the 2:35 p.m. school day. Transportation will also need to be arranged as KISD bus transportation will not be available.
- Cell phones must be turned off and stored in backpacks; students will not have access to their backpacks during testing or breaks.
- Students will report to the designated testing location by <u>7:30 a.m.</u> for morning exams and <u>11:30 a.m.</u> for afternoon exams. Students will receive information regarding the testing location via an e-mail sent from "Total Registration" to the e-mail listed on their Total Registration account. Seating charts with specific room numbers will be posted in the gym area on test day.
- A visible clock will be present in each exam room, with exam start and stop times posted. If a student chooses to wear a watch, it must not have internet capacity, beep, or have an alarm.
- Attendance will be notified of students who are taking AP exams, so students will not need to check in with their teachers prior to testing.
- Students who qualify for late testing will check in to the Counseling Office on their late testing date to receive their testing location (see College Board website for late testing dates/times).
- Students taking classes at Miller will be excused from Miller absences during AP tests;
 Students who have taken an AP course at Miller will test at JHS.
