THE COMMUNITY

Seven Lakes High School is located 30 miles west of downtown Houston. SLHS is Katy Independent School District's sixth high school. SLHS opened in 2005, and the Class of 2008 was the first graduating class. The school has an extremely diverse student population with families moving in from all over the world. The student body is representative of all socio-economic levels, but is primarily middle to upper middle class.

Seven Lakes High School faculty and staff are committed to creating a positive atmosphere that empowers students to develop strong character, achieve excellence, serve the community and become life-long learners in a diverse world. SCHOOL FACTS

Seven Lakes High School is a public, four-year secondary school with an enrollment of 3,548 students in grades nine through twelve. The Seven Lakes HS faculty is composed of 290 teachers and staff.

Seven Lakes High School is accredited by the Texas Education Agency and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Seven Lakes High School is also a member of CEEB, TACAC, and TASSP.

The school day consists of seven class periods which meet five days a week. Each class period is approximately 50 minutes in length. The school year is divided into two semesters with three six-week marking periods in each semester.

CLASS RANK

KISD uses a weighted 4.0 grading scale. Class Rank is based on a cumulative grade point average for grades 9-12, plus high school courses taken in junior high and credits earned via pre-approved Katy ISD provider(s). A student's GPA is calculated by dividing the total number of grade points by the number of semester courses attempted. Students are officially ranked for the first time after the fifth semester in high school. A full year, one period course consisting of two semesters would be equivalent to one credit.

DISTINGUISHED LEVEL OF ACHIEVEMENT

A student may earn a distinguished level of achievement by successfully completing all curriculum requirements for the Foundation High School Program, plus each of the following:

- A fourth credit in mathematics, which must include Algebra II;
- A fourth credit in science;
- The requirements of at least one endorsement.

A student must graduate with a Distinguished Level of Achievement to be considered for the Top 10% and eligible for automatic admission to a Texas public college or university.

PERFORMANCE ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

A student may earn a performance acknowledgement in one or more of the following categories:

- AP test score of 3 or above;
- IB test score of 4 or above (applies to transfer students only as the International Baccalaureate program is not offered in Katy ISD);
- Outstanding performance on the PSAT, SAT or ACT;
- Completion of at least 12 hours college coursework with final grades of A or B (3.0 GPA or above);
- Bilingualism and biliteracy; and
- Earning a state, nationally or internationally recognized business or industry certification or license.
