Common Questions

When Do Orchestra Classes Meet?

Orchestra classes meet daily during one of the student's 8 class periods. Beginning orchestra students are divided into like-instrument classes for specialized instruction.

I've never played an instrument before. Is that a problem?

Not at all! The elementary music classes prepare students for the beginning orchestra program. Beginning instrument skills, note reading, and music theory will all be taught in Orchestra class the very first year.

Is financial assistance available for orchestra students?

Yes. The Orchestra program does not want finances ever to prevent a student's orchestra participation. Please discuss any financial concerns with your orchestra director in regards to supplies, instrument rental, class fees, etc.

Does the school provide any instruments?

Yes, but only for cello & bass students. Due to their size, the district provides cellos and basses for students to use during class. There is a maintenance fee required for their use. Students will also rent an instrument for home and concert use.
