## 6th Grade Schedule

## Entering Courses in SchooLinks

- Students use their school username and password to access the SchooLinks tile on the Katy Cloud February $5^{\text {th }}$ - February $19^{\text {th. }}$
- Students use their course worksheet to choose the 4 core classes and elective for $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}$ grade.
- Enter alternate courses in order of preference.
- They must confirm the class and save.
- The $5^{\text {th }}$ grade counselor or teacher will check courses are entered correctly.
