# The Benefits of Taking a Career Course at Miller



Discover and explore possible careers and paths



Earn a credential in certain courses such as a certificate, certification, license or work experience through an internship



Real-world experiences through hands-on lab activities



College prep for post-secondary education and potential job opportunities

## Credits & Grades

- All CTE courses at Miller count as elective credits.
- SchoolLinks and the MCTC website include information about credit awarded for each course.
- Grades from Miller classes are included in KISD report cards and transcripts.
- Students do not graduate from Miller. They graduate from their regular high school campus.

# GPA Exemption

**All Miller CTE courses are eligible for GPA exemption.**

**This option can be beneficial for students with a GPA above 4.0.**





# Scheduling

- The Miller Counselor and the home campus Counselor can work together to schedule Miller and activities such as athletics and fine arts.
- Students attend Miller for half of the day—morning or afternoon (3 or 4 class periods).
- Many students take one or two core classes at Miller in addition to their CTE elective.



# Cost to Attend Miller

**There is no tuition.**

**Some programs require a fee for supplies or a uniform.**





# Eligibility to Attend Miller

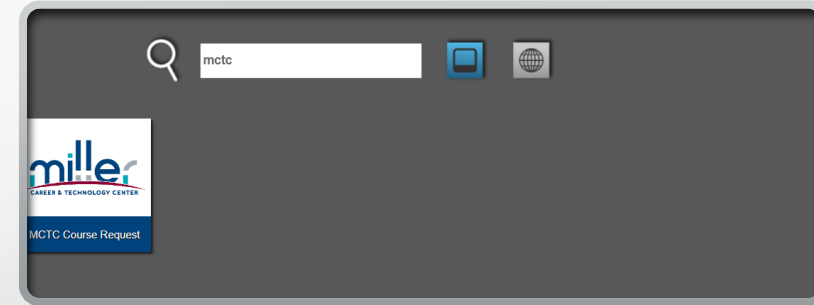
- Courses are open for current KISD 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders to request.
- Some courses have prerequisites which are listed in SchooLinks and the MCTC website.
- Students with internships must provide their own transportation.
  - Carpooling to internships with other students is not an option.

# Enrollment Criteria

- If requests for a course exceeds the maximum allowed enrollment, the student's request into a program may be determined by the following factors:
  - GPA
  - Attendance (unexcused absences)
  - Discipline referrals (detention hours, ISS, etc..)

- The MCTC Course Request window closes on February 28th at 11:59 pm.
- Students can request a course online through the Miller Career & Technology Center tile in MyKaty.

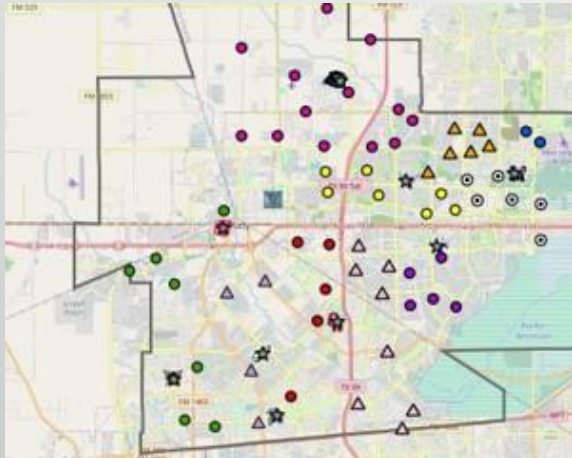

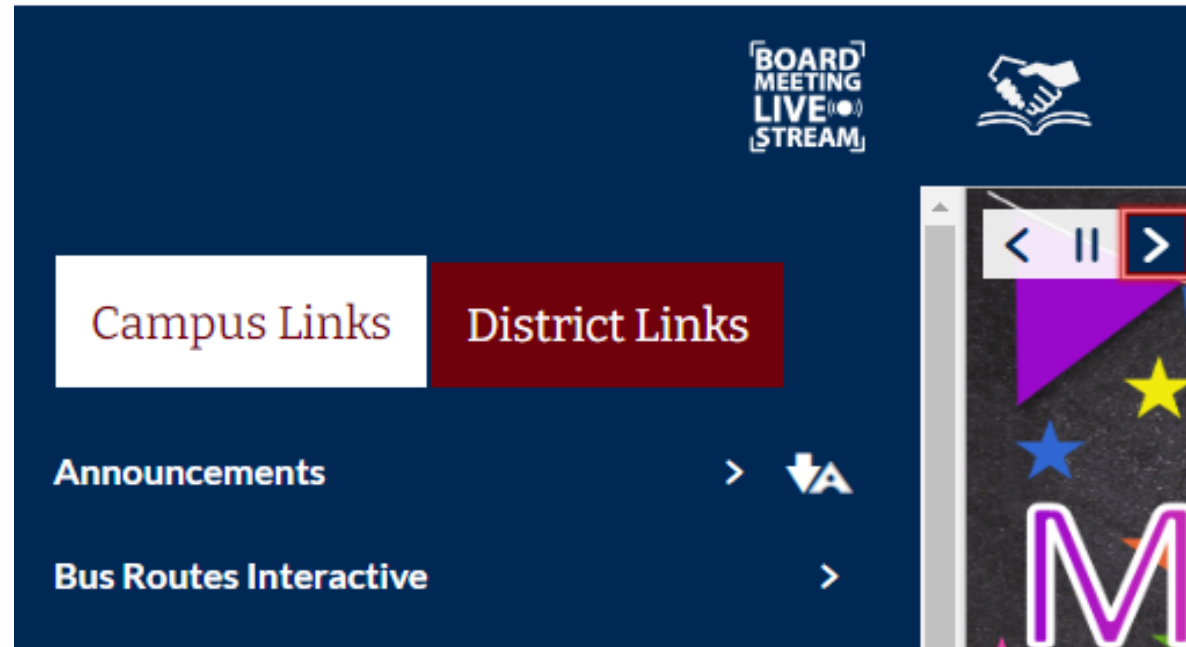
Morning	Afternoon
