What is a
**Three-
Year Plan?**

This is NOT a final document and can be edited each year of school.





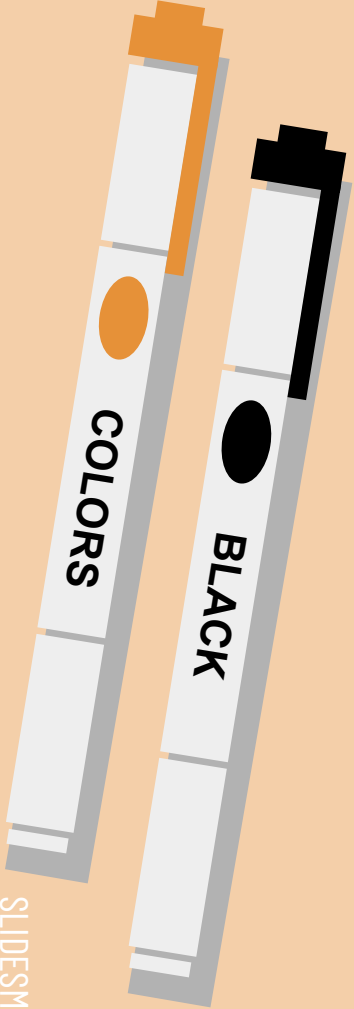
