On Wednesday, March 1, 2023 juniors will take the SAT School Day at their home campus and are automatically registered for this exam.

Katy ISD provides all students with academic opportunities needed to prepare them for college and beyond. Participation in the SAT School Day is an important step in preparing for college.

The School Day SAT is an important step for any student thinking about college and career. The SAT is accepted by all U.S. colleges; it measures what students are learning in high school and what they need to know to succeed in college and career. With SAT School Day, all students have access to this important stepping-stone. Students can choose which colleges, universities, and / or scholarship programs to send their four free score reports using their College Board account.

Students can prepare for this exam by reviewing the information in the SAT School Day Student Guide. They can also sign up for free practice on Khan Academy. Official SAT Practice on Khan Academy is FREE for all students and the best way to prepare. - Email address/mobile number (optional)

Score Reports will only be available electronically to students through their College Board account.
