## BEFORE AND/OR AFTER SCHOOL PROVIDER

Criminal history for employees who are a part of a Before and/or After School Program in the district.

Responsibilities:

The After School Program Provider is responsible for reviewing the criminal history of all their employees to ensure that no employee with a disqualifying conviction will be working on Katy ISD property in a before or after school program.

The After School Provider will obtain the necessary criminal history record and/or fingerprinting prior to the employee working on Katy ISD property.

The After School Provider will conduct continuous updates and reviews of background checks for existing and new employees.

Disqualifying Conviction:

The After School Program Provider employee is disqualified from working at the district if he/she has one of the following offenses (if at the time of the offense, the victim was under 18 or enrolled in a public school):

- 1. A felony offense under Title 5, Texas Penal Code:
- 2. An offense for which a defendant is required to register as a sex offender under Chapter 62, *Code of Criminal Procedure*; or
- 3. An equivalent offense under federal law or the laws of another state.
