Consequences for tardies at MCTC

- ✓ 5 total tardies to date in a semester = 1-hour detention (Level II)
- ✓ 8 total tardies to date in a semester = additional 2-hour detention (Level II)
- ✓ 11 total tardies to date in a semester = additional 2-hour detention (Level III)
- ✓ 10 tardy arrivals in a class period = Teachers may issue an "N" in Conduct
- ✓ 14 total tardies to date in a semester = additional 2-hour detention (Level III)
- ✓ Consequences for late arrivals to class will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and may be considered Persistent Level II.

Tardy accumulation period resets at semester

"A student is considered tardy when the student is not in the proper place with all needed materials **before** the tardy bell rings. Students with excessive tardies may be assigned disciplinary consequences." (Katy ISD Discipline Management Plan & Student Code of Conductpage 16).
