

# Any Vaping/e-Cigarette Offense Mandatory OAC Placement



### New State Law

In an effort to emphasize the dangerous and addictive nature of e-cigarettes and tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), the Texas Legislature passed HB114 into law requiring mandatory disciplinary alternative education program (DAEP) placements for vaping offenses.

School attire may not cause a material or substantial disruption of, or interference with, normal school operations. Failure to adhere to the dress for success expectations will result in disciplinary consequences.

## Student ID Replacement Cost

It is *mandatory* for students to wear their school ID's everyday while on campus.

If students forget their ID at home, they must get a temporary ID for that day from their grade level AP office. The cost for a temporary ID is \$1.00.

If a student has lost their ID, they can purchase a replacement ID for \$3.00 in either the 9th grade front office (freshmen-only) or the counselors' office (all other grades).

Lanyards and ID sleeves are also available to purchase for \$1.00 each. Payment can be made either in cash or through Pay N' Go.
