

- 1. An average of 80 or higher for the semester.

- The following absence codes do NOT count toward the five (5) allowable excused and unexcused absences: P: Present but not in class; S: School-sponsored curricular and extra-curricular activity that is not UIL related; V: UIL and other competitive activity
- 4. No more than TEN (10) tardies.
- 5. No N in conduct for the course and no U in conduct for any class.
- 6. No ISS, OSS, OAC/DAEP Placement, or JJAEP Placement.
- 7. No outstanding fees or fines.
- 8. Must have been enrolled in the course by the 10th day of instruction; and
- Meet campus specific requirements related to exemption submission deadlines and verification procedures for securing their exemptions.

Extra Attendance Incentive Exam Exemption:

To qualify, you must meet the following criteria this semester.

- 3 or fewer absences for any one class.
- Complete the Google Doc if you've met all exemption criteria for grades, discipline, & absences <u>https://tinyurl.com/THSExempt</u>
- If approved, the exemption will be added to the Exam Exemption Tile.

Student ID Replacement Cost

It is *mandatory* for students to wear their school ID's everyday while on campus.

If students forget their ID at home, they must get a temporary ID for that day from their grade level AP office. The cost for a temporary ID is \$1.00.

If a student has lost their ID, they can purchase a replacement ID for \$3.00 in either the 9th grade front office (freshmen-only) or the counselors' office (all other grades).

Lanyards and ID sleeves are also available to purchase for \$1.00 each. Payment can be made either in cash or through Pay N' Go.
