Legacy Guest Guidelines

At the request of the Fire Marshal and Katy ISD Legacy Stadium Officials, the following guidelines must be followed:

- Guests will enter through the home and visitor gates.
- Graduates will enter through assigned graduate gate.
- Do not block or stand in the aisles or on ramps to take pictures.
- Only Katy ISD approved photographers are permitted on the field.
- No signs larger than a poster board are permitted.
- No signs of any kind can be attached to the railings or walls.
- No helium balloons, air horns, and laser pointers are permitted.
- No glass containers of any kind (including vases) are permitted.
- No outside food/beverages are permitted. Concession will be available for purchase.
- The KatyISD Clear Bag Policy will be enforced.

Graduate Guidelines

Each high school campus will attach specific campus information to the District graduation information.

Graduate gate assignments with cap and gown distribution.

- Graduates are encouraged to iron gowns prior to the ceremony.
- Graduates must carry their cap and gown during Legacy Stadium check-in at assigned gate.
- Prior to the start of the graduation ceremony, graduates must have caps on and gowns
- Caps may not be decorated.
- Caps must be worn flat on the head and tassels placed on the right side.
- Comfortable clothing and shoes are recommended. High heels are not recommended due to the Legacy Stadium turf.
- Graduate violations of the required dress code and behavior guidelines may result in the graduate not participating in the ceremony.
- Exemplary achievement medals may be worn when approved by the principal. The following criteria for cords, cowls, and medals have been established:

APPROVED

CORDS - High Honor graduates, Honor graduates, graduates completing 60 hours of confirmed community service through campus-sponsored service efforts, graduates who have earned a cord from a state, national or international organization for scholarship, service or leadership as approved by the principal, and senior members of the Superintendent's Student Roundtable.

COWLS - Military, National Honor Society, senior class officers, valedictorian, and salutatorian only.

MEDALS - District-awarded medals for students graduating under the KISD Distinguished Achievement Plan, medals earned with a KISD Award of Excellence, medals won for state or national-level awards (principal's approval required), or campus-awarded medals for students who have met campus-designated requirements (principal's approval required).
