



Board of Trustees Resolution

Whereas, HB 1842 provides that a school district is eligible for designation as a district of innovation if the district's most recent performance rating under Education Code 39.054 reflects at least acceptable performance, and that consideration of designation as a district of innovation may be initiated by a resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees of the District;

Whereas, the Katy ISD has a long-standing tradition of supporting innovations for the benefit of students;

Whereas, the Katy ISD Board of Trustees believes, as a body, it can make better decisions for students when it has the freedom to exercise greater local control over the decision-making process;

Therefore, the Board of Trustees of the Katy Independent School District, by adoption of this resolution, initiates the process of exploring and considering designation under Education Code Chapter 12A as district of innovation.

Be it further resolved, that after this resolution is signed by the Board President, a public hearing shall be held to consider whether the District should develop a local innovation plan for the designation of the District as a district of innovation and that after the public hearing, the Board of Trustees of Katy ISD shall appoint a committee to develop a local innovation plan or decline to pursue designation as a district of innovation.
